Students of First Nation, Métis and Inuit ancestry can choose to voluntarily and confidentially self-identify so that they may benefit from supportive programs and services provided by the board. By doing so, students also enable educators to identify, review, and analyze data that will contribute to improving programs and services for First Nation, Métis and Inuit students.
